



ASK TRAINING PLANNER

The ASK Training Planner will help you in your career and professional development. The training planner is designed to be used with the **Framework for Practitioners** and the **ASK Distribution Grid**. Complete your training planner using the following steps.

1. Estimate your Framework level.
2. Locate your Framework level on the ASK Distribution Grid. Then simply fill in the first row with the information.
3. Fill in your current training in ASK Core Areas located in Section 9 of your application.
4. The last line gives you the difference of training between what is expected by the ASK Distribution Grid and what you actually have taken. With this information, you have to opportunity to target your future training to obtain a specific goal.
