## *The Hawai'i P-20 Initiative*

### **P-3 MINI-GRANT FACT SHEET, *Spring 2008 and Fall 2008***

Hawai'i P-3 Initiative: *Capturing the Momentum* is soliciting applications for proposals to support planning for P-3 concept in communities throughout Hawai'i. The one-year competitive grants, funded by a grant from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation, will range from \$500-5000.

All projects must focus on children in the range from birth to grade three and must be aligned to the state's direction to help every child to achieve high standards and to read on grade level by the third grade. Proposals should promote a strong collaborative partnership--including early childhood organizations and elementary schools--within the community.

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this grant is to provide communities an opportunity to initiate activities and projects that support planning for the P-3 concept and that promote readiness to implement the P-3 concept.

#### **Application Due Date & Grant Award Period**

The proposal must include: P-3 Mini-Grant Cover Sheet and Proposal Narrative.

October 2009- October 2010

#### **Grant Awards**

Grant awards will range from \$500-5000. The implementation grant funds must supplement and not supplant existing resources.

#### **Eligibility**

Each project must include elementary schools, early childhood organizations and/or community-based organizations. Priority will be given to applications which include at least two elementary schools *and* representatives from the early childhood organizations, and agencies or organizations in that community.

#### **Reporting Requirements**

A mid-year progress report and a final report are required.

#### **Technical Assistance**

Grantees will be invited to participate in quarterly grantee meetings (but their participation is voluntary). Grantees may receive technical assistance from Good Beginnings Alliance P-3 staff.
